Health Care for Your Child

MEDICAL HOME

What is it? Why is it important?

Shots are an important part of your child's health care, but your child also needs regular checkups with his/her doctor or clinic.

Every child should have a medical home. A medical home is not an actual house or building but a style of health care. It means that your child is seen by the same health provider (doctor, nurse practitioner or physician's assistant) for well visits and when your child is sick.

Why? When a health care provider regularly sees your child to check hearing, vision, and physical (height and weight) and mental development, the provider can tell if everything is going well. If problems are found, they can be taken care of early. A medical home is a partnership between a family and the child's health care provider.

WHEN WAS YOUR CHILD'S LAST CHECKUP?

Routine checkups at your child's medical home are needed at these ages:

- 2 weeks old
- 2 months old
- 4 months old
- 6 months old
- 9 months old
- 12 months old
- 15 months old
- 18 months old
- 2 years old
- 3 years old
- 4 years old
- 5 years old
- every year while a teenager



THANK YOU FOR VACCINATING YOUR CHILD!

Please keep a copy of your child's shot record.

Your child's shot record is very important, so keep it safe. You will need this shot record when you enroll your child in child care, preschool and elementary school. Always bring it with you when you take your child to a doctor or clinic.

HEALTH INSURANCE FOR YOUR CHILD

Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+)—for low-cost health insurance for children 18 years of age and younger without Medicaid, call 1-800-359-1991.

Medicaid—apply at your county Department of Social/Human Services. (Look in the blue pages of your phone book.) For information about Medicaid and other programs for the uninsured, call 303-866-3513 x2120 if you live in the Denver metro area or 1-800-221-3943 if you live outside the metro area. There will be a wait time to speak with someone.

MEDICAL CARE AT A DISCOUNT

Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP) provides

- financial help and referrals to a network of hospitals and clinics;
- temporary and emergency services for low-income, uninsured Coloradans not qualified to receive Medicaid or CHP+.

FINDING A MEDICAL HOME FOR YOUR CHILD

The Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment Program (EPSDT) can assist families enrolled in Medicaid in finding a medical home for their children. Call 303-866-6167 or 303-866-6006.

Health Colorado assists Medicaid clients in finding a doctor or clinic. Call 303-839-2120 in the Denver metro area or 1-888-367-6557 if you live outside the metro area.
